

MSc in Oncology Application for Admission - Guidance for Applicants

1. All applications should be made on The Institute of Cancer Research application form in either typescript or block capitals.
2. Please complete all sections on the form, writing 'N/A' should any section not be applicable.
3. Please enclose your Curriculum Vitae with your application.
4. Photocopies of certificates and/or transcripts in respect of qualifications held should be enclosed with the application. Successful candidates will also need to supply the original documents at enrolment.
5. You should provide a personal statement (section G) outlining your reasons for applying to join the course. If further space is needed please continue on a separate page, clearly marking it with your name.
6. If you are a non-native English speaker you should provide evidence of your English language ability by supplying a recent IELTS or TOEFL certificate. All applicants whose first language is not English must be able to demonstrate a proficiency in English to the equivalent to an IELTS score of 7.0.
7. If you wish to be considered for accreditation of prior learning (APL - section I) please detail the learning you wish to accredit.
8. Documented evidence should also be submitted. Applicants are advised to read the excerpt from the ICR's Regulation concerning the Credit Transfer and the Accreditation of Prior Learning before completing this section.
9. All applicants are asked to complete section K: Fee Assessment Questionnaire. You may also be asked to provide further supporting documentation.
10. Please complete section L: Referees, and ask your referees to fill out the Confidential Reference Form. Your referees should be;
 - a. Your educational supervisor or a colleague at ST6 and above and
 - b. Another senior oncologist

NB. References written by colleagues currently on the MSc Course will not be considered. Your references should be returned in a separate envelop with your application.

11. Applicants are also required to complete the Equal Opportunities and Disability Support Information Form, please enclose this form with your application.
12. Please sign and date your application form.
13. Please submit one passport sized photograph with your application – please print your name on the back of the photograph.

15. All applications will be considered by the Course Admissions Team in accordance with the ICR's Admissions Policy, which can be downloaded from the 'Entry Requirements' page on the website.
